



## AUSTRIAN DODGEBALL LEAGUE 25/26 SCHEDULE EXPLANATION

### 1. REGULAR SEASON

#### Mixed 1st League

- The competition has 9 teams.
- All teams play each other once over 4 gamedays.
- After that and before GD5, the table will be split in 2 groups:
  - Position 1-5 (Top)
  - Position 6-9 (Bottom)
- Within those 2 groups teams play each other on GD5 and GD6 for positioning.
- This means, in the top-group each team has 4 games total and in the bottom-group each team has 3 games total.
- On GD5 and GD6, teams cannot drop from the top-group into the bottom-group, as well as teams cannot climb up into the top-group from the bottom-group on those gamedays.
- After 6 gamedays each team will therefore then have played **11 or 12 games** total for the regular season, depending if they have qualified for the top- or bottom group after GD4.

#### Mixed 2nd League

- The competition has 8 teams.
- All teams play each other twice over 6 gamedays.
- After 6 gamedays each team will therefore then have played **14 games** total for the regular season.
- Not all teams play on every gameday, teams play on 4 or 5 gamedays out of the 6 total.

#### Men 1st League / Men 2nd League / Women 1st League / Women 2nd League

- All 4 competitions have 5 teams.
- All teams play each other 3 times over 6 gamedays.
- After 6 gamedays each team will therefore then have played **12 games** total for the regular season.
- Not all teams play on every gameday, teams play on 4 or 5 gamedays out of the 6 total.

### 2. PLAYOFFS

#### Mixed 1st League – 9 Teams

Playoffs will be played based on the table positions.

- Play-In A8vsA9 to determine 8th QF-Spot.
- Quarterfinals: A1vsA8 / A2vsA7 / A3vsA6 / A4vsA5
- Semifinals: Winner A4A5vsA1A8 & Winner A2A7vsA3A6 are paired.
- Final

Positioning Games:

- All teams that are not reaching the final will have positioning games to determine the places 3<sup>rd</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup>. Each team not reaching the final will have 1, 2 or 3 positioning games.



### Mixed 2nd League – 8 Teams

Playoffs will be played based on the table positions.

- Quarterfinals: A1vsA8 / A2vsA7 / A3vsA6 / A4vsA5
- Semifinals: Winner A4A5vsA1A8 & Winner A2A7vsA3A6 are paired.
- Final

Positioning Games:

- All teams that are not reaching the final will have positioning games to determine the places 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. Each team not reaching the final will have 1 or 2 positioning games.

### Men 1st League / Men 2nd League / Women 1st League / Women 2nd League – 5 Teams

- Play-In A4vsA5 to determine 4th SF-Spot.
- A1vsA4 & A2vsA3 semifinal
- final.

Positioning Games:

- In these 4 competitions there will only be the Game for third place as a positioning game. The playin-loser will not have any further games.
